“Wine tastings can be held for your private party, at your home or at a location of your choice.”

During the tasting you and your guests will enjoy the experience by means of handy tips on how to taste wine, how to read a label and more.

The Dutchman is obviously open to your wine related questions and will try to answer them all.

You may become a connoisseur by the end of it... not always playing it safe in your choices, and trying something new in the future.

Tastings are held at the beginning of your event programme. Recommended group sizes for your tasting is 10 persons. A maximum is approx. 20.

Tastings consist of 6 wines, 3 whites and 3 reds, originating from France, Chile and Australia[†].

You may choose to enhance your event by supplying candles, water glasses, water jugs and baskets of dry biscuits and/or French bread, as these will not be supplied by The Dutchman.

The Dutchman recommends not to serve strongly flavoured canapés or other types of appetisers before or during the tastings. He also recommends that you keep the wine tasting as a surprise for your guests. Experience shows that this makes for a more relaxed and enjoyable event.
